Learning objectives

- Understand that dinosaurs and other fossilised animals lived a long time ago
- Acknowledge that some fossils look like living animals
- Understand that dinosaurs were not all the same. Some were very small and some were very big
- Understand that we can find fossils in the ground
- Identify people who look for fossils as palaeontologists

Workshop content - students will:

- Investigate fossils and other artefacts using their sense of touch
- Make their own cast of a fossil
- Search for fossils like a palaeontologist
- Learn about the size of some dinosaurs
- Think about what ancient animals might have sounded like
