

# Space stories planetarium show



## Learning outcomes

Students will learn about:

- The Earth as a planet in space
- Other planets
- How we get into space and astronauts
- Stars and patterns of stars

## Show content - students will:

- Watch beautiful images of Earth, stars and planets
- Be awed by the planetarium stars
- Listen to a story about a bear who goes exploring in space and music
- Participate in the story with actions and noises

## More information

- Written for KS1 students
- Multi-sensory experience with music, voice, visuals and objects to feel
- Lively presenter-led show
- Lots of participation with noises and actions
- Caters for all different learning styles
- Duration 20 minutes but can be reduced
- Students can leave during the show if necessary
- Lights will not be down for long and are presenter-controlled and can be brought up if required
- Accessible for wheelchairs
- Toilets nearby

Format is:

1. Students sitting in planetarium seats
2. A few colourful slides on Earth, Sun, planets and space, then bring lights right down to experience planetarium stars
3. Lights up again for a participatory story about Ernest the bear who climbs a tree, grabs the Moon, hops onto Saturn and Mars and returns back to Earth, having left some stars in the sky in the shape of a bear.
